




- The Action Clock will be dealer-controlled.
- Dealers will start the Action Clock once the last card is dealt, and reset when the action is complete from each player.
- If a player requests a count, the Action Clock "may" be paused. The dealer will then count out the bet/raise (total amount), announce it, and then restart the Action Clock.
- Each player will receive five (5), 30-second time extension buttons.
- Players will throw out the buttons in a forward motion and, the dealer will press the time extension button to add 30 more seconds to the Action Clock.
- All unused extensions will be removed when six players remain, and all six final table players will receive four (4), 30-second time extension buttons.
